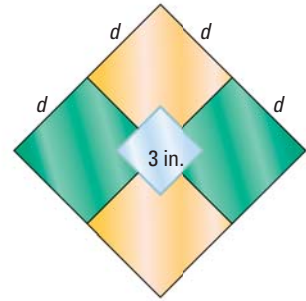

- Explain how to find the sum of the odd integers from 11 to 21.
- How many rows of chairs will you need for the outdoor play? Explain your thinking.

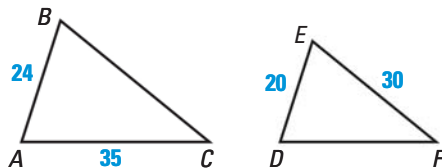
